

Removing “no print” Code

The University has purchased the Respondus Lockdown Browser, which is a custom browser which locks down the testing environment within Blackboard.

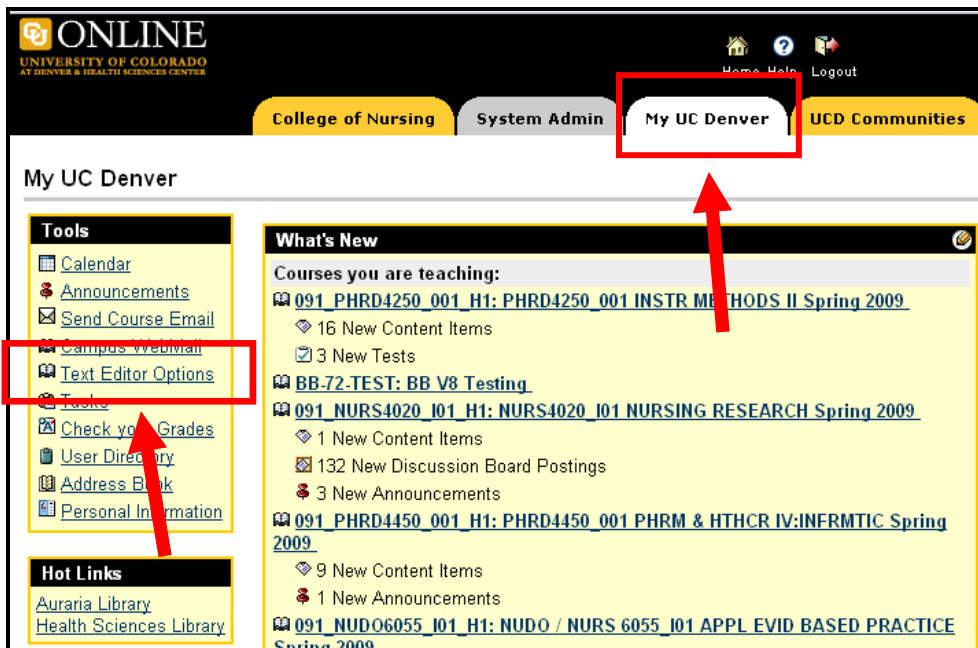
Students will be unable to print, copy, or have multiple web browsers and URLs open. When launching an assessment, the student is locked into it until they submit it for grading.

Prior to purchasing the Lockdown Browser, faculty used a “no print” code that was developed by Princeton University. It has come to our attention that the “no print” code has been conflicting with other apps such as the Respondus Lockdown Browser.

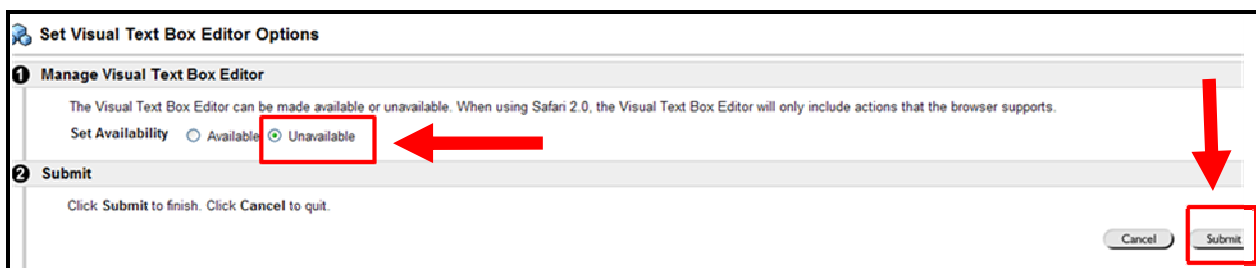
It is recommended that faculty remove this code from their assessment and use the Respondus Lockdown Browser instead.

NOTE: It is imperative that you follow these instructions; otherwise it will not be removed properly

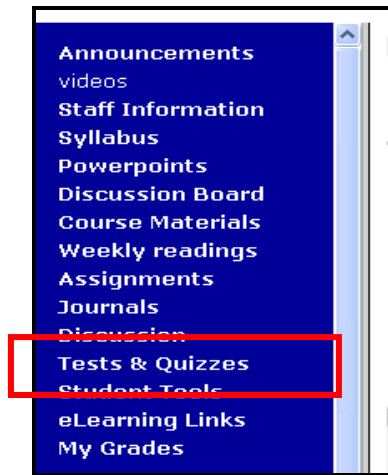
1. You first need to set the **Text Editor Option** to **Unavailable**. Click on the **My UC Denver** tab. From the **Tools** menu, select **Text Editor Options**.



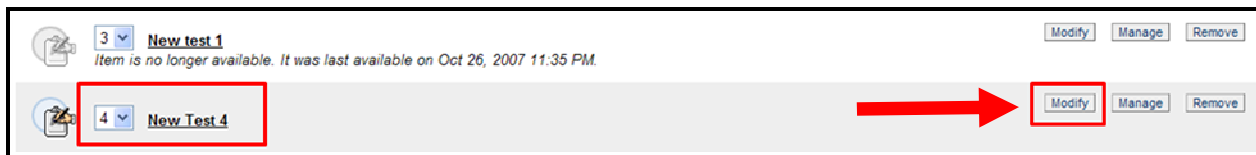
2. Set the **Visual Text Box Editor** to **Unavailable**, then click the **Submit** button.



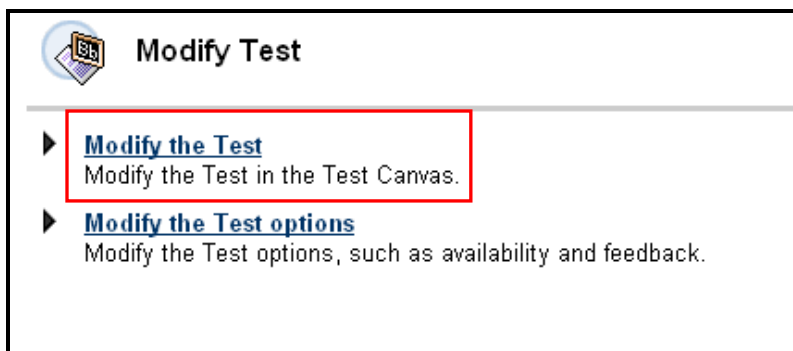
3. Go back into your course and select the link where the **exam/test/quiz** is.




4. Click on the **Modify** button.



5. Next select **Modify the Test**.



6. Click the **Modify** button to change the **Name, Description** and **Instructions** of the exam/test/quiz.
7. The “no print” code is found within the Instructions field. **REMOVE THIS.**
