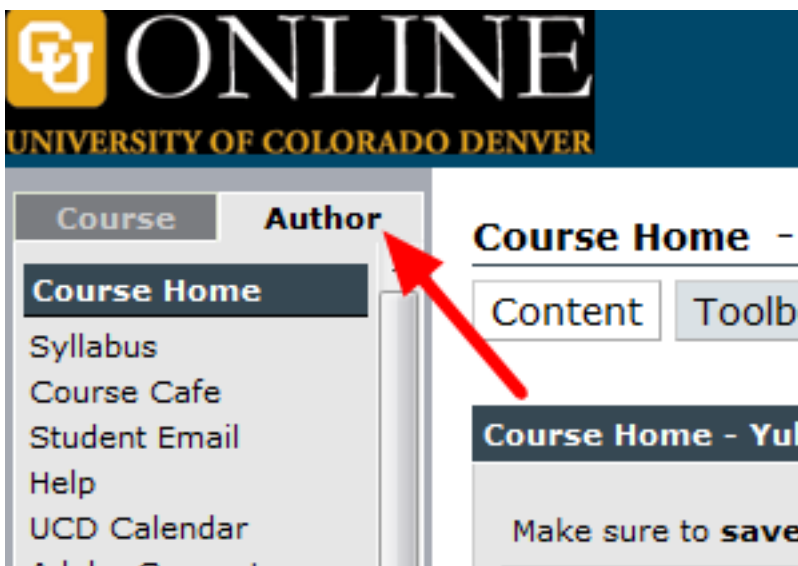


Using a Video Embed Code in eCollege

These steps will explain how to insert a video embed code into an eCollege content item.

Click "Author" Mode



After logging into your course shell, enter "author" mode by clicking the tab.

Select or Create the Course item you wish to insert the video embed.

The Video embed will need to reside within a course item. Select an existing item or create a new one for your video. This could include a "Threaded Discussion or Text / Multimedia" item

Select "HTML" Mode



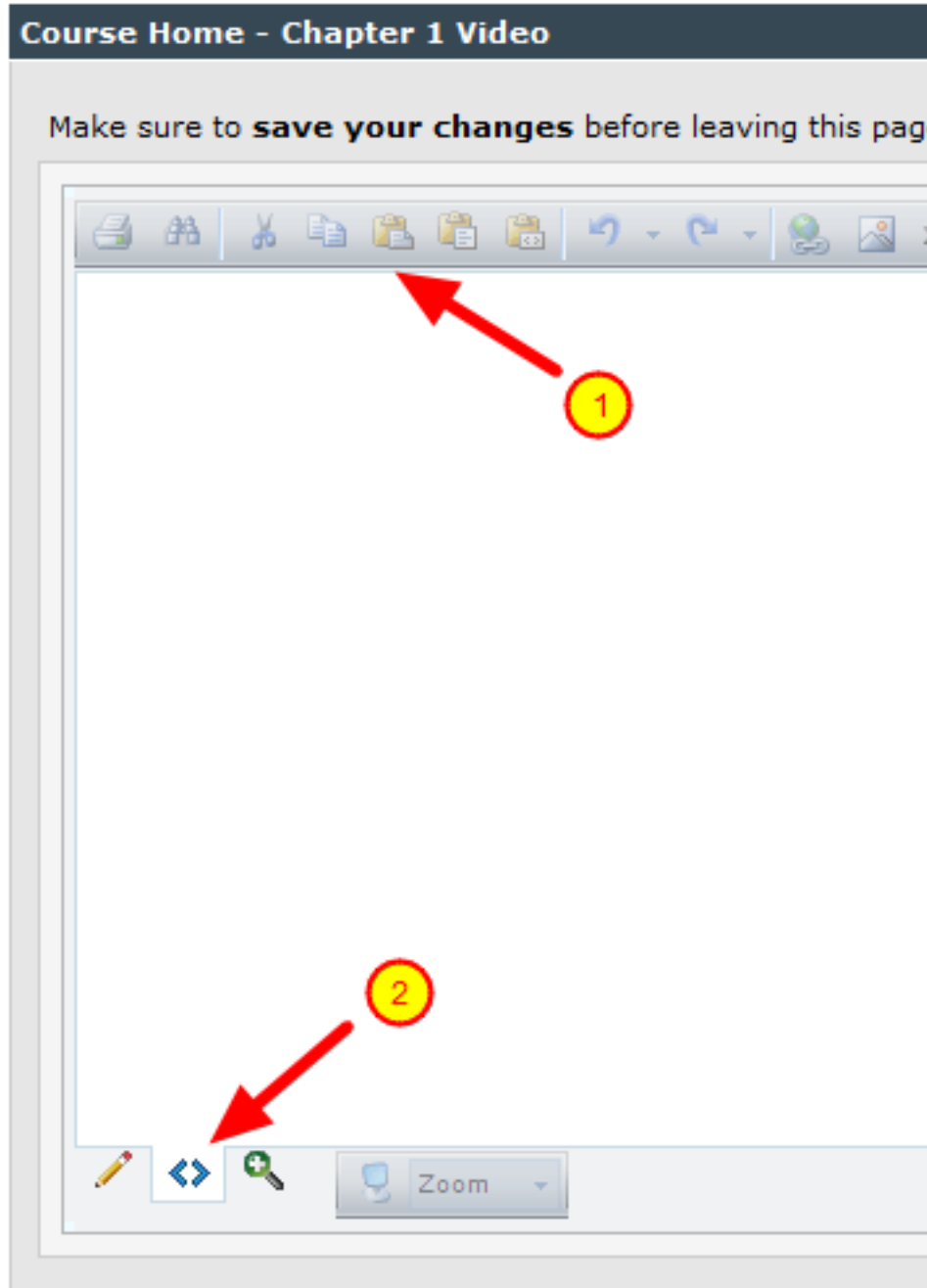



Save Changes

1. Highlight and copy your selected embed code from its original source and paste it into the HTML window.
2. Click the "Save Changes" button at the bottom right corner of the HTML window.
