Entry Monument

The Center created several options and revised these to create a final entry monument design for the two entries off of I-25 to the Town of Fountain. The final entry monument incorporated the recently developed wayfinding signage, the river stone character of Fountain Creek and a reference to the railroad that went through Fountain. In fact, Fountain celebrates one day each year commemorating the blowing up of a railroad car in the late 1800's. The new entry sign will be more visible to highway traffic and give a true sense of the character and interests of the town of Fountain.
