This year's camp is both a day camp and a residential. Campers can decide whether to join us for the day only or to campout with us each night to deepen their learning and experience.

Tuition per camper is \$375 if we receive a deposit of \$200 (which includes \$50 nonrefundable processing fee) by **May 25**. Full payment is due by **June 30**.
