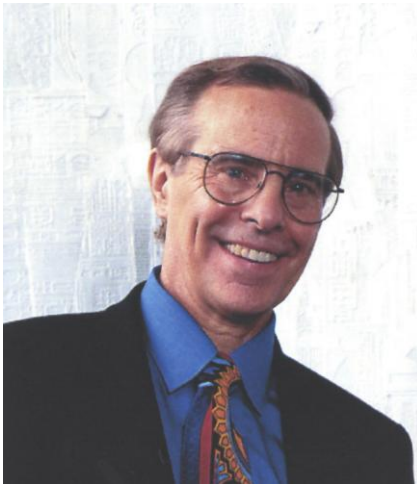

Dr. Lawrence L. Kazmerski served as Director of the National Center for Photovoltaics from 1999-2008. He received his B.S.E.E. in 1967, M.S.E.E. in 1968, and his Ph.D. degree in electrical engineering in 1970 from the University of Notre Dame. He was SERI's first staff member in photovoltaics. He has held adjunct professorships at the University of Colorado, Colorado School of Mines, and the University of Denver. Dr. Kazmerski has published over 320 journal papers, authored or edited four books, and serves on the editorial board of several journals (i.e. Elsevier: Renewable and Sustainable Energy Reviews)—and he has more than 160 invited presentations at international conferences, workshops, and seminars. He was co-founder and editor of the journal SOLAR CELLS, published by Elsevier-Sequoia (1979-1991). Kazmerski has received numerous awards and recognition from various organizations such as AVS and ASES. In December 2008, he was the United Kingdom ISES David Hall Memorial Lecturer and in January 2009, he was elected as Honorary Professor at Strömstad Academy in Sweden. Recently, Kazmerski was inducted into the Environmental Hall of Fame in the Field of Solar Energy (Photovoltaics Technology).
