

TRANSFER CHART

Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice & Associate of General Studies – Emphasis in Criminal Justice

The following chart can be used to illustrate the transfer agreement between the Associate of General Studies (AGS) degree with a Criminal Justice emphasis from Colorado Community Colleges to the Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminal Justice at the University of Colorado Denver.

The chart shows how transferable courses from the AGS with a Criminal Justice emphasis apply to the University of Colorado Denver’s Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice program.

Elective courses for the AGS need to be approved by the CJ Program Coordinator for transfer. All transfer courses must have been completed in the last 10 years with minimum letter grade of “C-” or better.

The general degree requirements for a Bachelor’s of Arts are:

1. 120 total semester credit hours passed
2. 34-36 semester credit hours in UCDHSC general education core curriculum
3. 46-48 semester credit hours in general electives
4. Minimum 45 semester hours of upper-division course work (3000 and above)
5. Minimum of 30 hours of resident credit; 21 out of the last 30 hours in resident course work
6. Minimum of 2.0 CU cumulative grade point average

The general Criminal Justice Major requirements are:

1. 21 semester credit hours in required criminal justice courses
2. 15 semester credit hours in criminal justice and ancillary fields for a selected concentration
3. 18 upper level (3000 or higher) semester credit hours in criminal justice
4. Sociology 1001- Intro Sociology (also fulfills core social science requirement)
5. Completion of a 3 credit hour internship unless officially waived from prior experience
6. Minimum of a C (2.0) in each undergraduate course used to satisfy major requirements
