

# **RMCIBER Network Conference – November 13-15, 2008**

## *Announcement*

We are pleased to invite you and your colleagues to the Rocky Mountain CIBER Network Conference on November 13-15, 2008 in Logan, Utah at Utah State University.

This should be a great opportunity to learn how to write international business case studies, find out how to incorporate experiential learning into your courses, share innovative international ideas with Utah State University and other Rocky Mountain schools, network with other business faculty from the Rocky Mountain region, discuss the financial environment of the European Union and its impact on the United States, and learn about a highly successful company involved in international nuclear waste remediation as well as in nuclear power management. If you arrive by plane, you may want to schedule your arrival to meet the complimentary bus which will take conference participants to Logan, leaving at 2:15 pm Thursday, November 13 in front of Salt Lake City International Airport (meet at Baggage Claim at 2:10 pm – look for a RMCIBER sign). If you are scheduled to arrive at an alternate time, you may wish to contact Cache Valley Airport Shuttle, which, if you make reservations at least 48 hours in advance, will take passengers from SLC to Logan (\$52 one way or \$126 one way if the flight arrives between 11:30 pm and 6:30 am - \$92 regular roundtrip fare).

Registration will begin at 3:00 pm on Thursday afternoon, followed by the opening dinner at 6:00 pm. Meetings will begin at 8:00 am on Friday morning and go all day. A site visit to EnergySolutions in Clive, Utah will occur Saturday, November 15. Then the bus will drop participants at Salt Lake City International Airport (2:20 pm or later flights are suggested).

There is no registration fee for this conference which includes the program plus two breakfasts, two lunches, and two dinners.
